

Southland Age Championships 2016

Saturday October 29th 2016

The combined Trampoline clubs of Southland invite you to join them for a recreational competition to be held on October 29th 2016 in Te Anau

This competition is aimed at the recreational bouncer but competitive bouncers are most welcome.

Venue: Te Anau Events Centre

Equipment: 2x Eurotramp trampolines, 1x Eurotramp DMT, Double Layer of matting for recreational tumbling.

Entry Fee: \$30 per athlete (regardless of how many events entered)

Entries: Entries Close Wednesday 19th October 2016 at 8pm.

Events to be competed:

Trampoline: 6U (invitational) 8U, 10U, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17+ both Men and Women

A 10 bounce (voluntary) routine is required. Two **voluntary** routines will be performed.

DMT: 6U (invitational) 8U, 10U, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17+ both Men and Women Four passes will be performed.

For DMT a developmental option is available for 6U and 8U age groups only. (No run up and four **compulsory** passes)

Tumbling: 6U (invitational) 8U, 10U, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17+ both Men and Women

Tumbling will be judged in the following class only

Recreational – 5-skill pass (cartwheels etc). Two **compulsory** passes will be performed.

Synchro: (invitational). It is intended that this be a fun end to the competition for bouncers to have a go at synchro. Mixed pairings are allowed and will be competed in 10U, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, and 17+ 10 Bounce routine required. Two **voluntary** routines will be performed.

All competition will be dependent on Judge numbers and availability.

Dress: Please remember this is a regional competition and TIDY DRESS is essential.

Girls are to wear leotards and white foot covering below the ankle. Boys -leotards and plain shorts for DMT, and long white trampoline pants for trampoline, plus white foot covering.

Alternatively, **plain** T-shirt and **plain** shorts with white below ankle foot covering will be permitted.

No jewelry or watches permitted. This is a safety issue and the marshals will inspect athletes.

Leotards from other disciplines (not club colour) are permitted.

Timetable: Confirmed once entries have been received and judge's confirmed. The competition is expected to begin with a general warm-up starting around 8.30am. Training may be available on Friday evening. These times will be finalised once entries are received.
