### **Junior Selection Policy**

As stated in the MAG National Programme Manual, there is no national qualification standard for eligibility for Juniors to attend the National Championships. However, if the number of entries exceeds the maximum number of gymnasts who can be accommodated in the one day (48), a policy will be put in place which will protect the entitlement of each province to enter one team of three or four gymnasts in each level.

Should the number of entries exceed 48, the one team entitlement rule will be put in place and all additional gymnasts will be ranked to determine entry. If this situation occurs, provinces will be provided with a form to complete for their additional gymnasts, showing the gymnast's two highest AA scores achieved at 2017 Qualifying Competitions. These two scores will be totalled to calculate a final score and based on this final score, gymnasts will be ranked to determine whose entries will be accepted.

Provinces must still enter, through the normal process, all gymnasts who wish to compete at the 2017 National Championships. The above only comes into play if the number of entries as at the closing date (16 August) exceeds 48.

### **Start Values**

All clubs running senior qualifying competitions must ensure start values are included in the results sent to Gymnastics New Zealand.
