# **Entry fee clarifications:**

**Aerobics** athletes competing as an individual pay the \$110.00 entry fee. If they are also competing in an Aerobics Team event, the team pay the fee of \$60.00.

**Rhythmic** athletes competing as an individual pay the \$140.00 entry fee. If they are also competing in a Rhythmic Group event, the group pay the fee of \$100.00.

The \$25.00 extra GymSports category is also applicable for athletes wishing to compete in more than one code (e.g. if an athlete competes in Aerobics and Women's Artistic Gymnastics they will pay \$140.00 + \$25.00).

### Judges Fee:

A judge fee will be applied based on the flight expenses and judging requirements during the past two years. The process for selecting and arranging travel for judges will remain the same as previous years. If an athlete competes in multiple codes, only the higher of the applicable judge fees will be payable. Judge fees will be invoiced with entry fees.
