# Artistic Gymnastics, Team Performance Tumbling and Trampoline

Through movement, Gymnastics NZ will lead New Zealanders to do better, feel better and be better

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#### **ELIGIBILITY**

All year 9-13 students enrolled full time at a New Zealand secondary school and under the age of 19 as at 1 January 2017 are eligible to compete.

#### **UNIFORM**

All athletes must wear their school tracksuit while in the warm-up or competition area.

Please refer to the General Manual for additional requirements regarding competition attire.

#### **EVENT REGISTRATION**

All event registrations are to be completed online by your school sports coordinator. One entry per school. Individual or club entries will not be accepted – all entries must be submitted by your school.

**Entries close at 12.00pm on Friday 6th August 2018.** All entries must be received electronically by this date. Once entries close, an invoice will be sent to schools and is payable within 7 days.

Registration Fees

Individual entries - \$50 per athlete Team Performance - \$100 per group

The individual entry registration fee of \$50 per athlete covers entry into as many of the following events as you like: individual and team competitions for Men's Artistic Gymnastics, Women's Artistic Gymnastics, Tumbling and Trampoline. The only event with a separate entry fee is Team Performance.

## **ACCREDITATION**

All event participants, coaches and support staff will receive an accreditation pass based on the number of athletes participating. Accreditation passes allow free entry into the venue.

Only participants competing in the current session will be allowed into the competition area. All other participants are to remain in the spectator area supporting their team.

Only registered staff will be accredited and allowed onto the competition floor.

#### **Staff Accreditation**

A maximum of one staff member per code entered per school will be accredited. Requests for additional staff can be made to the Events Manager at the time of registration and will be granted based on registration numbers.



## **MUSIC**

All participants must bring a copy of their music on a clearly labelled CD. All music must be handed in at the registration desk at least one hour prior to their competition starting time. Participants must also bring a backup CD.
