QUALIFYING SCORES

WOMEN'S ARTISTIC GYMNASTICS

The following scores are to be achieved at a minimum of **two** qualifying events to be eligible for selection to the 2018 New Zealand Gymnastics Championships. **One of these events must be outside the athlete's home province.**

This means that a gymnast much achieve a qualifying score at 2 **different** competitions, one of which must be outside their home region. Where a competition has Day 1 and Day 2, the gymnast may count the score from either Day 1 or Day 2 as their qualifying score.

MENS ARTISTIC GYMNASTICS

The following scores are to be achieved at a minimum of one qualifying event to be eligible for selection to the 2018 New Zealand Gymnastics Championships. In addition, all athletes must attend at least two qualifying events (or overseas competitions if representing New Zealand).

Senior Open has a selection req of – 63.000 based on 2013 FIG Code of Points and changes thereafter.

There is no national qualification standard for Levels 4, 5 & 6 to enter the 2018 New Zealand Gymnastics Championships. If the number of entries exceeds the maximum number of gymnasts who can be accommodated in the one day competition, a policy will be put in place which will protect the entitlement of each Province to enter one team of 3 or 4 gymnasts in each level and make application for additional entries of individuals and/or teams over and above this entitlement.

RHYTHMIC GYMNASTICS

This year the 2018 New Zealand Gymnastics Championships will have a maximum of 20 athletes accepted for each Rhythmic Gymnastics level. In the event that more than 20 athletes qualify in any level, athletes will be ranked and the top 20 athletes will be invited to enter the competition. The ranking will be made using the following criteria: Averaging the highest total scores achieved from three qualifying competitions. If an athlete competes in four qualifying competitions, the lowest scoring competition would not be used to calculate their average score. If an athlete competes in three qualifying competitions or less, all scores will be used. In Levels 4, 5, 6 and 7 there are more than 20 gymnasts registered and competing at sanctioned events. The above selection process will therefore be necessary for these levels.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Age requirement: to compete in the 2018 New Zealand Gymnastic Championships, athletes must be turning 9 years of age by December 2018.

Registration deadline: Wednesday 15th August 2018 12:00pm

Please note that the entry fee includes what was previously known as the 'Judge Fee' in 2017. The slight increase from last year is based on inflation and the cost associated with hosting all codes at the same venue.

Submission of Entries: entries will only be accepted from the Provincial Coordinators – they will not be accepted from clubs. International entries will be eligible and considered for participation if received from Gymnastics Federations, State/Regions or on special invitation from Gymnastics New Zealand.
