The General Gymnastics Advisor will be responsible for providing advice, direction and leadership on all Gym For All (GFA) artistic matters in accordance with the Sport Development Committee (SDC) Terms of Reference and Technical Committee Regulations* through the following actions –

- Input into the development of resources for GFA artistic based activity.
- Provide advice and support to Gymnastics New Zealand (GNZ) on all artistic matters.
- Remain up to date with current GFA artistic gymnastics practices and developments both nationally and internationally.
- Contribute to the draft annual SDC Work Plan.
- Implement initiatives as outlined in the annual SDC Work Plan relevant to the SDC role.
- Work with GNZ staff and working groups to achieve GFA outcomes as per the SDC annual Work Plan.
- Gain an understanding of Physical Literacy and providing quality experiences for lifelong engagement in physical activity.
- Have inclusivity at front of mind in all aspects of GFA.
- Where appropriate, consult or liaise with, GNZ employees, key stakeholders, advisory groups and the wider GFA artistic community.
- Attend a minimum of three SDC meetings per year.

Desired criteria:

- Experience in the GFA artistic programming area.
- A relevant qualification through either the GNZ pathway or overseas equivalent.
- Experience in school gymnastics delivery would be beneficial.
- Demonstrated collaborative and effective relationships within the wider gymnastics community.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills
