- Willing to work in and foster a Team Coaching environment with coaches of all abilities and experiences.
- Ability to create coaching and training plans in collaboration with other coaches and less experienced coaches.
- Have a commitment to continuous quality improvement of the WAG programme always keeping in mind the desire of the Club to provide quality training not quantity.
