



## Manager: Recreational Competitive

Kapiti Gymnastics Club, 8 Scaife Drive, Mazengarb Reserve, Kapiti Coast

The Kapiti Gymnastics Club was established in the 1980's running out of small community hall in Raumati. The original purpose built facility was built in 1997 with a significant extension completed in 2018. The Kapiti Gymnastics Board currently employs nearly 20 paid coaches and administrators. Kapiti Gymnastics Club currently has approximately 350 recreational members, 50 competitive members and a large number of Schools, Kindys, Preschools and private groups regularly attending the facility. With an extended facility the Kapiti Gymnastics Club is now embarking on a significant growth and development phase to both increase the numbers of members using our facility, and to increase and diversify the range of gymnastics codes and pathways available.

**Position Overview:** Kapiti Gymnastics Club is seeking a manager and gymnastics coach to enhance, redesign, implement and manage the clubs Recreational Competitive Programmes, with the ability to assist with WAG and MAG competitive codes as and when required.

The successful applicant will be required to completely redevelop the existing Gym For All and Incentive programmes with the view to creating multiple pathways for recreational competitive gymnasts at Kapiti Gymnastics Club, including but not limited to Excel, Team Gym, and other recreational competitive programmes. The successful applicant will maintain effective communication to the Kapiti Gymnastics Board on matters regarding the development and management of the recreational competitive programmes.

Extra emphasis will go towards those applicants who hold either: Gymnastics New Zealand (GNZ) recognised coaching qualifications, equivalent Gymnastic coaching qualifications, prior gymnastics experience (particularly in Excel or Recreational competitive programmes) and/or a willingness to train and move through the GNZ Coaching Framework gaining qualifications as required.

Applicant will work in conjunction with the clubs other two management positions:

- Manager: Community, Schools and Pre-schools
- Manager: Competitive

**Salary:** The salary range for this position will be negotiated with individual employees subject to experience and skill level. This is a full time role (40 hours) across weekdays, evenings and weekends as required.
