Dear Community,

The Board of Gymnastics New Zealand have determined and set the entry fees for the 2020 New Zealand Gymnastics Championships, to be held from 15-18 July in Auckland, as outlined below:

<b>TRAMPOLINE**</b>	\$185
<b>RHYTHMIC INDIVIDUAL</b>	\$190
<b>RHYTHMIC GROUP</b>	\$100 (per group)
<b>RHYTHMIC ATHLETE COMPETING IN GROUP ONLY<sup>+</sup></b>	\$50
<b>ARTISTIC</b>	\$190
<b>AEROBICS</b>	\$140
<b>AEROBICS GROUP</b>	\$60 (per group)
<b>EXTRA CODE</b>	\$50

\*Note that all amounts are GST inclusive.

\*\*In 2020, there is only one entry fee for trampoline athletes. This covers multiple disciplines as long as the athlete has qualified and been registered to compete in each discipline. The Trampoline equipment levy of \$15.00 per athlete is included in this Entry fee, further clarification on the equipment levy is provided below.

<sup>+</sup>If a Rhythmic athlete is competing in a Rhythmic Group only and not also as an individual they will be charged a \$50.00 Entry fee. The Group will still be charged the \$100.00 Group Entry fee.

Please note that the entry fee includes what was previously known as the 'Judge Fee'.

## MEMORANDUM

Dear Trampoline and Tumbling Clubs,

For the 2019 Nationals a \$15.00 equipment levy was put in place by GNZ and the TRA Technical Committee to ensure the best possible equipment is available for use during the championships. In preparation for the 2020 National Championships we have included the \$15.00 equipment levy into the 2020 Nationals Entry fee of \$185.00 for all trampoline, double mini trampoline, and tumbling athletes. The fee will ensure that we can provide the athletes with high quality equipment in order to make their National Championships an enjoyable and safe competition. It will also ensure equipment providers are adequately compensated for time lost without equipment, and wear and tear.

Athletes competing in multiple disciplines and codes will be charged once only for the equipment levy as outline below:

Trampoline and Tumbling – Charged Equipment levy once only

DMT and Tumbling - Charged Equipment levy once only

Trampoline, DMT and Tumbling - Charged Equipment levy once only

DMT and another code (e.g. Artistic) - Charged Equipment levy once only

Tumbling and another code (e.g. Artistic) – Charged Equipment levy once only

Trampoline and another code (e.g. Artistic) - Charged Equipment levy once only
