Dear Community,

Gymnastics New Zealand has implemented a number of actions and procedures to stay across the threat Covid-19 exposes our athletes, visiting athletes, staff and events team, an overview of our current approach is as follows;

- The Events team are monitoring and updating our event risk assessment daily.
- The Board and Senior Leadership Team are holding bi-weekly teleconferences to discuss Pacific Rim and the Oceania Gymnastics Continental Championships, with an emphasis on risk assessment, mitigation and actions. Covid-19 is a permanent agenda item and forms part of the event risk assessment process, appearing in our risk management plan and project plans.
- Our Pacific Rim 2020 website has a notice and links to the proper advice (Ministry of Health and Immigration). This is updated with any other information felt appropriate. This is the site that all international teams access for information about the event.
- None of the countries that appear on the restricted entry or self-isolation lists (as of today) are attending the event.
- Event plans are in development to ensure there is ample signage and access to the recommended sanitation material for the event itself. This will be finalised following a site visit on Wednesday 18 March.

We are constantly monitoring the available information from the Ministries of Health and Immigration. Any changes or updates regarding Pacific Rim and Oceania Gymnastics Continental Championships will be shared with the community as a matter of priority.
