Registrations

Registration for coaching courses must be completed via the Gymnastics NZ [Club Portal](#). For anyone wishing to observe all, or part, of a course, please email education@gymnasticsnz.com.

Registrations close at 5.00 pm on Wednesday, December 16, 2020. Registrations received after this time will incur a late fee of \$30.00 per person due to the extra administration time required to make any adjustments. Clubs will be invoiced for each participant after the closing date.

Details of the modules, including skills covered in each course, are provided in the [Gymnastics NZ Education handbook](#). Coaches must attend and actively participate in 100% of the course modules to gain their qualification.

Eligibility to apply as a course participant

- To register for a Junior Advanced Coach course, participants must have fully completed a Junior Coach qualification, and be a minimum age of 18 years of age
- To register for a Junior Coach course, participants must have fully completed an Elementary Coach qualification and be a minimum age of 17 years of age

Demonstrators

Gymnastics NZ encourages, where possible, coaches to bring their own athlete to GymSchool so hands-on learning practice may be gained. Gymnastics NZ will also organise some demonstrators, but it is good for coaches to practice skills/drills with the gymnasts they will be working with. There is no fee for gymnasts to attend with coaches.
