

NZ Secondary Schools Gymnastic Sports Cup



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The NZSS Gymnastic Sports Cup is a multi-code Tier 2 Secondary Schools event that is sanctioned by School Sport NZ (NZ Secondary School Sport Council). Elegibility:

Secondary School students entering the event must be:

- Enrolled full time at school of representation
- In Year 9 or above. No entries from athletes in Year 7 or 8 will be accepted
- Under 19 years on 1 January 2020

No competitive athletes who have competed in the current year may compete in the gymnastics code they are a competitive athlete in. The exception is in Rhythmic Group where a limit is placed on the number of competitive Rhythmic gymnasts than can compete in each group. Current competitive athletes or gymnasts may compete in another gymnastics code. Should any students wish to submit a dispensation request as to the Grade they wish to compete, please contact Leanne Olsen (leanne.olsen@tristar.org.nz) for more info.

Only SCHOOLS are able to enter athletes into this competition.
Entries coming from clubs WILL NOT be accepted.



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Entry Fees & Info:

Artistic (MAG & WAG) - \$50.00

Trampoline/Double Mini/Tumbling - \$50.00 (covers entry in 1, 2 or 3 of these disciplines (e.g. can compete both TRA and DMT for \$50.00)

Rhythmic Gymnastics (individual) - \$50.00

Rhythmic Group - \$25.00/group member (4-6 members)

Aerodance (group 5-8 members)- \$25.00/group member

Aerobics (individual) - \$50.00

Aerobics (pair) \$50.00 (trio) \$75.00 (team) \$25.00/team member

Team Performance - \$150.00/team

Additional Code - \$25.00/code (e.g. competing in MAG and Trampoline, total would be \$75.00)

Entries are to be sent in on the official Tri Star Championships Entry Form by the school. School name and a school contact person must be provided on the entry form for the entry to be considered. Amounts are GST inclusive.

Entries must be received no later than Monday 26 July. Please submit to leanne.olsen@tristar.org.nz.

Music:

Upon the receipt of your entries, Tri Star will send out a Music Upload Link and instructions for loading your music files. We require files in Mp3 format. Please bring a back up USB on the day.

Consent Form:

Entries to the NZSS competitions must have approval from school principals of each student. Schools entering athletes must submit the consent form listing each student who is entered to compete. The principal must sign and date to verify:

- Student eligibility
- Approval to enter the division and
- Consent for any photo, livestreaming or other imagery of students that may be made public
- The signed and approved form is to be submitted with the entry form unless otherwise arranged with the Event Director.

Awards:

Invoicing & Withdrawals:

Tri Star will send out invoices upon receipt of entry. Please do not remit any payments prior to receiving the invoice. The only refund given to an athlete who withdraws from entering the New Zealand Secondary Schools Gymsports Championships will be for medical reasons. A refund based on 80% of the entry fee will be processed once the school has submitted a completed Request for Withdrawal form and the athlete's medical certificate to the host club. No other refunds will be given for other costs/fees related with entering the event. Please submit medical certificates and requests for withdrawals forms by 25 July 2021 at the latest. Refunds will not be processed after this date.

Coaching:

The minimum number of coaches required to be on the competition floor is one per code. It is the responsibility of each school to ensure the coaches on the competition floor have the relevant coach qualifications or safety training to safely support the athletes/gymnasts they are with. You will need to submit the names of the intended coaches to the Event Director prior to the start of the competition. There is a coach registration section on the Event Entry Form. Coaches will be required to check in at the Coach Table upon arrival to Tri Star.

Covid:

Tri Star will adhere to any applicable Covid protocols required by the government at the time of the event.
