Judging Advisor – Technical Committee

POSITION TITLE: Judging Advisor

PURPOSE The Judging Advisor will be responsible for the provision of guidance and advice on all judging matters in accordance with the Technical Committee Terms of Reference and Regulations through the following actions

KEY

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Working with the Gymnastics NZ Education Manager to develop and implement judge education within the National Education Framework and TC work plan.
- Provide technical advice and support to Gymnastics NZ on improvements and developments to the manuals, resources, courses and training forums for judges.
- Where appropriate ensure the Code is in alignment with the FIG Code of Points.
- Considering the above, apply a strategic lens to the application of the FIG Code of Points across the competitive programme.
- In line with the National Education Framework, and in conjunction with the Education and Events Managers:
 - Verify accreditation.
 - Verify judging panels for endorsed and qualifying competitions, including control judges.
- In collaboration with the GNZ Education Manager, establish a development and succession plan for judges.
- Develop a 4-year judging plan for International judges that results from domestic pathways.
- Establish criteria for a judge to be eligible to attend an FIG brevet course.
- Establish criteria for judges to be eligible to attend the GNZ National Championships and international competitions.
- Where appropriate, consult or liaise with, Gymnastics NZ

employees, key stakeholders, advisory groups, and the wider Code community.

- Where required consult with the Judging Advisor of other Technical Committees to share best practice and cross Code alignments.
- Work in collaboration with the TC Chairperson to contribute the required judging elements to the draft annual TC Work Plan
- Attend a minimum of three Technical Committee meetings per year and, where required, attend meetings requested by the Gymnastics NZ Board or Chief Executive Officer.
