As the home of Counties Manukau Gymnastics, the Centre and Club work collaboratively to run both recreational and developmental programmes for the local community, and programmes for the more competitive gymnasts.

We are seeking coaches who can complement our existing team. We run Pre-School programme, Educational School programme, after-school Recreation membership programmes during the week and weekend. We also have competitive training programmes for Artistic Gymnastics (Men's and Women's), Rhythmic, Trampoline and Tumbling.

Position Description

This is a part-time Tumbling Coach role (approx. 15 hours) with the potential to include additional weekend hours. You will be coaching our competitive International and Age Level Tumbling programmes. You may also be required to coach some recreational classes of all ages and abilities with a view to progress gymnasts into a development pathway to competitive programmes. You will have the opportunity and support to advance your coaching qualification with further courses and training.

To fulfil this role, we seek someone:

- With good communication skills
- Confident and have a positive attitude
- Who is a team player
- With coaching experience in Tumbling Gymnastics
- Who ideally has a minimum Gymnastics New Zealand Junior Coach Qualification or the equivalent
- With a current First Aid certificate (can be trained)

This position is expected to start in January 2022. Pulman Recreation Centre takes pride in supporting staff and providing opportunities to grow and develop. There is an opportunity in this role to have more hours coaching in other programmes.
