Key Responsibilities

- Oversee the WAG Competitive Programme in conjunction with the Manager
- Provide high level coaching and programme development for the WAG competitive programme, creating an environment that provides opportunities for gymnasts to go as far as they have the drive and desire to do so, including to National or International representation
- Keep up to date with code changes and developments in the WAG and FIG programmes and share this knowledge with relevant staff
- Provide coaching and judging (if possible) at competitions where Kapiti Gymnastics is represented
- Ensure detailed planning, goal setting and feedback processes between coaches, athletes and parents in the WAG competitive programme
- In liaison with the Manager, MAG, GFA and Excel Head Coaches provide timely planning of term and holiday training scheduling, and the yearly competition calendar
- Development of all coaches within the WAG competitive programmes, informally during class time as well as ensuring coaches are formally qualified to an appropriate level (where applicable)
- Assist the Manager to co-ordinate the organisation of the Kapiti Gymnastics home competitions
- Assist the Manager to co-ordinate competition entries for competitions.
- Follow club policies and procedures for athlete and coach safety, injury management and building security
- Comply with all aspects of the Gymnastics New Zealand Code of Conduct
- Influence and facilitate the development of a growing sporting organisation
- Work in partnership with a committed and forward-thinking governance body

- Excellent leadership and communication skills
- Excellent time management capability & organisational talent
- Recognised GNZ Senior Coaching qualification or international equivalent, or the desire and ability to obtain the appropriate qualifications
