



CLUB MANAGER POSITION – Permanent Part-time

Based in Pukekohe, Franklin Gymsports caters for 450 members in a range of recreation classes such as preschool, GymFun, tumbling, disability, adult gym, school holiday programmes and birthday parties, and a thriving competitive artistic gymnastics programme competing up to the National level. We host events such as recreation and artistic competitions, schools' festivals and club champs. We employ 25-30 staff.

In this role you will:

- support our passion for youth participating in gym sports to gain fundamental movement skills and have fun doing it, and
- support our highly specialised competitive programmes in our invitational elite pathway.

The Club Manager is responsible for:

- Day to day club operations and event management
- Leading and supporting our team
- Governance liaison with our committee
- Implementing the strategic plan and leading development of the club and its sustainability

Prior experience in a sporting code or not-for-profit would be an advantage but no prior gymnastics experience is necessary as you will be working alongside our qualified Programme Lead's and the governance committee, with assistance from Gymnastics NZ.

This role is approximately 25 hours per week and has a pay range of between \$26 and \$29 per hour dependent on skills and experience. We have some flexibility on hours of work and availability, alongside a need to be present in the gym during peak participant times. We will do our best to accommodate the successful candidate's circumstances. We envisage appointing this role to begin early in January 2023.
