Following the <u>September 2022 Community update</u> on the of <u>Shaping the Future of Gymnastics in Aotearoa Work Plan</u>, we wanted to reconnect to report on the continued progress we are making with this important mahi.

The Gymnastics NZ Steering Committee (GNZSC) have met three times since September, once in person and twice virtually. Along with general updates, project management reviews and communication strategies, GNSZSC members specifically discussed priority actions from the Integrity theme of the work plan. This included covering a full review, discussion and recommendations related to I2: Counselling, I3: Complaints & Discipline, I4: Tamariki & Rangatahi Child Focus on Concerns, Complains and Discipline as well as I6: Tamariki, Rangatahi & Gymnastics Athlete initiatives. These topics were carefully evaluated before final recommendations were formulated to be presented to the Board of Gymnastics New Zealand for consideration.

The GNZSC and the GNZ Board have then actioned the following items:

#### Theme One: Integrity

- 12: Counselling
  - Five recommendations for future best practice improvement for Gymnastics NZ to consider implementing.
- 13: Complaints and Discipline
  - Review of current state, collation of best practice and six recommendations for future best practice improvement for Gymnastics NZ to consider implementing.
- 14: Tamariki & Rangatahi Child Focus on Concerns, Complaints and Discipline
  - Letter from GNZSC and GNZ Board to the ITC requesting that they
    ensure that complaints processes are developed with a childfriendly approach, ensuring that they are suitable for athletes of
    all ages to engage with.









#### 16: Tamariki, Rangatahi & Gymnastics Athletes

 Letter from GNZSC and GNZ Board to the Children's Commissioner (Judge Frances Eivers) inviting the Children's Commissioner to consider placing a stronger focus on the Kaupapa of children and sport and in particular the advancement of children's rights within the sports context in Aotearoa.

Priority actions I1: Restorative Processes, I5: Gymnastics Athlete Voice & Empowerment and I7: Ongoing Monitoring are scheduled for committee discussion at the first GZNSC meetings on the 1 February 2023. While work on the Shaping the Future of Gymnastics in Aotearoa plan will continue through 2023 and 2024, the GNZSC are prioritising the rapid response to the Integrity theme and aim to have all priority actions completed from the committee work by second half of 2023.

Gymnastics New Zealand continues to work on the remaining three themes (Health & Wellbeing, Environment & Culture and People & Programmes) of the Shaping the Future of Gymnastics in Aotearoa Work Plan. This includes specific updates on the following priority actions:

#### Theme 2: Health & Wellbeing

M2: Gymnastics Athlete Framework

 Initial discussions with research partners to explore gymnastics best practice regarding training (age and stage), selection, calendar, and competition age appropriateness. This research will inform the development of a long-term athlete development framework and also input into the development of the Medical Advisory Panel (M1).

#### **Theme Three: Environment & Culture**

E1: GNZ Role in leading culture

 This is closely tied with the development of a new strategic plan for Gymnastics NZ which is planned for 2023. Initial Board level discussion underway and wider community consultation will feed into this.

## E2: GNZ supporting Club culture

 Communication plan in place to ensure the community is kept up to date with progress of work plan and to promote and highlight good practice examples within the community.









## Theme Four: People & Programmes

P1: Coaching

- Coach Development Framework research phase completed, and research report shared with community
- Coach Connect Conferences held in Auckland and Christchurch. These conferences were developed as an early action to address the key themes identified within the framework research. The conferences were well attended, and feedback has been very positive. These will be the first of a range of actions designed to create more connection within the coaching community and to share information and ideas.

The GNZSC are scheduled to meet a further four times in the first half of 2023 to continue their role in overseeing progress of the work plan.

The table below provides further information on each priority action in the Shaping the Future of Gymnastics in Aotearoa Work plan, and this will be developed into our project tracker in 2023.
