

## ITT - RG 2025 USA Tour

This form serves as the Intention to Travel (ITT) for the RG tours to Koop Cup, Canada.

### Tour

Event / dates: Koop Cup (17<sup>th</sup> –22<sup>nd</sup> April 2024)  
Plus another event not yet determined

### Information

Tour Type: National Competitive (Participation)

### Eligibility:

Gymnasts competing in 2024 at Levels 7, 8, 9, and 10, or as Junior/Senior International, stage 4 and born after 2011, are eligible to trial. For our levels programme gymnasts, the grades offered at the events we attend will be age based, therefore the composition of the team will be dependent on the year of birth of the gymnasts, not necessarily the NZL level they compete in. We will also offer Junior and Senior international as per FIG rules.

We appreciate that some gymnasts who would be in the same age category will not trial directly against each other and this will be taken into consideration when setting the qualification scores. Gymnasts who compete in level 7 or 8 at the 2024 nationals will be eligible for selection in the Canadian Provincial grades, they will compete three apparatus routines in Canada and their top three scores at nationals will be taken into account for selection. Gymnasts who compete in level 9 or 10 at the 2024 nationals will be eligible for selection in the Canadian Junior and Senior Open Grades, they will compete four apparatus routines.

Gymnasts who compete in Junior or Senior International at the 2024 nationals who will compete level 9 or 10 in NZL in 2025 are eligible for selection in the Canadian Junior and Senior Open Grades Gymnasts who compete in Junior or Senior International at the 2024 nationals will be eligible for selection in the Junior and Senior HP grades in Canada (FIG rules). Gymnasts who are competing in Junior International at the 2024 nationals and who will be first year Senior International in 2025 will need to achieve the Junior International score at the trial to be eligible for selection for Senior.



Approximate travel dates: 15th-24th February 2025.





Estimate cost: \$8000-10,000
