The ability to teach a variety of classes and levels is desirable.

Lead Recreational Programme Coach

This coaching opportunity has responsibility for the coordination and development of our Recreational Programme, mentoring and training our Junior recreational coaching team. Strong experience with a Recreational Programme of all levels from preschool to advanced levels is essential.

Junior Recreational Coach

We have opportunities for part time junior recreational coaching staff to join our team, working alongside our Lead Recreational Coach to further coaching skills and experience. A gymnastics background or coaching experience is desirable and coaches will be supported through the GNZ coach development programme.
