The Gymnastics Programme Manager is responsible for planning and organisation of all aspects of the gymnastics programme. This includes setting the annual calendar and programme plan, organising and controlling programme activities, the safety and management of the gymnastics programme within the centre, its equipment and facilities and activities.

The role is a split between coaching and programme development requirements.



General Responsibilities

- Reporting to the General Manager the role will lead the development and delivery of our activity programme.
- Develop and implement an innovative activity programme to maximise the use of the facility. Proactively identify and implement ways to improve experience, grow participation and increase retention.
- Provide regular reporting and communications on programme achievements. Work with the General Manager to establish appropriate operational metrics.
- Consistently deliver excellent outcomes for members, gymnasts and coaches.
- Recruit, retain, develop, nurture and motivate a high-performing coaching and judging team.
- Ensure our coaches wellbeing is prioritised, workforce planning is timely and effective, and appropriate staffing levels are maintained so that activities are delivered safely and operated efficiently.
- Ensure the facility and its equipment are fit for purpose and maintained to an appropriate safe operating standard. Report Health & Safety requirements, concerns and investigations to the General Manager.
- Respond to general enquiries from the membership as required.
- Comply with all ESGC policies, procedures, and values.
- Promote an inclusive culture that welcomes gymnasts and staff from diverse backgrounds.
- Attend appropriate training and development opportunities as required.

- Judging experience is a plus, and a willingness to mentor junior judges is beneficial.
