Background:

Gymnastics New Zealand is the national governing body for gymnastics in New Zealand and a member of the World Gymnastics. We support the sport across all gym codes, from grassroots participation through to high-performance athletes. Our codes include men's and women's artistic gymnastics, rhythmic, aerobics, trampoline and GNZ parkour as well as recreation.

With a vision to become New Zealand's first choice of sport, Gymnastics New Zealand continues to experience strong growth in participation and competitive numbers. Whether people take the foundation skills they learn into other sports, or remain in one of our codes, we aim to provide outstanding experiences and outcomes.

Gymnastics New Zealand's Board comprises four elected members and three appointed members. In accordance with the Constitution, a Board Appointments Panel has been established to seek candidates for positions becoming available at the AGM in June 2026. Candidates for elected positions will be sought through a club nomination process, and candidates for appointed positions through an open process.

Skills/competencies:

We are seeking an experienced governance contributor with sound judgement and practical insights to support the Board's decision-making. For this appointed role, applicants must have a strong accounting/finance background and be willing to serve as Chair of the Audit and Risk Committee.

The Board Appointments Panel is seeking a candidate with broad leadership and governance experience. This may include senior-level management roles, and governance experience as a director, trustee, or in a similar role in either the commercial or not-for-profit sectors. For this vacancy, candidates must bring deep finance/accounting capability and the confidence to provide leadership oversight as Chair of the Audit and Risk Committee.

The criteria that applicants will be judged against include, but is not limited to the following criteria:

- Experience as a director, trustee or in other governance roles.
- Knowledge of, and experience in sport at a high performance or community level
- Strong accounting/finance expertise, ideally including audit, risk management, and/or financial governance experience.
- Willingness and capability to serve as Chair of the Audit and Risk Committee.
- Strategic ability and stakeholder focus.
