

Trials for 2026 Trampoline World Championships and World Age Group Competitions

3 June 2026

For athletes trialling for World Championships and World Age Group Competitions, the international selection process at both South Island Championships and North Island Championships will include an additional post-event review process conducted by a dedicated FIG brevet review panel.

The scores awarded on the day by the event judging panels will remain the official competition results for South Island Championships and North Island Championships.

For international trial athletes only, routines/passes will also be reviewed following the event by the FIG review panel, with these reviewed scores forming the official scores used for international selection purposes.

This process is being implemented to provide as much consistency and fairness as possible across both trial events nationwide, while aligning the selection pathway more closely with international FIG judging practices and procedures.

Trial scores used for international selection purposes will remain provisional until the review process has been completed. Confirmed official trial scores will be released within 14 days following each event.

We would like to sincerely thank all judges supporting these events. On-the-day judging remains a hugely important part of delivering competitions and supporting athlete development across New Zealand, and we greatly appreciate the time, expertise, and commitment our judging community continues to give to the sport.
